2019 Honoree

ANDREW E. HEALEY

Born in Brooklyn, Andrew E. Healey is the oldest of five children, to Claire and Joseph Healey. The Healey Family can trace their Irish heritage to County Cork, Ireland. Andrew's father was the former Commanding Officer of the famed "Fighting 69th" Regiment and the former Commanding General of the famed "42" Rainbow Division of the United States Army. Andrew, along with his brother T.J. and his three sisters, Monica, Maureen, and Meaghan, were raised in Rockville Centre and have spent over 60 summers in "The Irish Riviera" of Breezy Point, NY. A graduate of St. Agnes Grammar School and St. Agnes Cathedral High School, Andrew attended St. John's University and graduated with honors from C. W. Post College. Mr. Healey is a Major Degree member of the Ancient Order of Hibernians (AOH) Division # 17 - St. Brendan the Navigator (Long Beach, Island Park & Point Lookout, NY), and served as Divisional President from 2006-2009. Presently, Mr. Healey is on the Nassau County AOH Board as Chairman of Charities & Missions. He presently serves as Co-Chairman of a truly historic and unique Irish-American project, the restoration and preservation of two tragic shipwrecks - from 1836, The Bristol & 1837 The Mexico, (whose monument is located in the Rockville Cemetery in Lynbrook). The committee refurbished and rededicated the Mariner's Monument in 2015, on the 175th Anniversary of the building of the monument. Additional improvements recognizing these shipwrecks have been added each year, at the monument in Lynbrook, in Long Beach on the boardwalk, and this October in the Rockaways on the boardwalk.



Mr. Healey is a long-time member of the New York City St. Patrick's Day Parade & Celebration Committee. On March 17, 2011, he was awarded the "Chairman's Award of Appreciation" for his unwavering support and continued outstanding dedication to the 250th New York City St. Patrick's Parade. In Rockville Centre, Mr. Healey is also a charter member of the RVC St. Patrick's Committee and presently serves as the Secretary on the Executive Board Committee. In March 2005, he was the "Aide to the Grand Marshall" -- his father, Major General Joseph A. Healey. Additionally, Mr. Healey is a member in good standing with "The Society of the Friendly Sons of St. Patrick on Long Island" Nassau and Suffolk Counties. He was elected President of the Society in October 2017. Mr. Healey has been a member of the Coalition for Father Duffy/Times Square Project and is affiliated with the Regimental Headquarters of the "Fighting 69th". He has been a long-time member of the Board of Directors for the Irish Americans in Government and as an Advisory Member of the Irish Studies Institute at Molloy College. In March of 2010, the New York City Queens County AOH Board honored Mr. Healey as Deputy Grand Marshal for their Parade. In March of 2019, Mr. Healey was the recipient of the Town of Hempstead's "Certificate of Recognition" Irish American Heritage Celebration.

Mr. Healey has held a variety of professional positions over the years, as an employee of the Village of Rockville Centre, a teacher at Huntington HS, and as a member of BOCES in Nassau County. Additionally, Mr. Healey has worked in the manufacturing industry and the retail business (he was employed by both JC Penney's and Bloomingdales). He has been recognized on numerous occasions for his outstanding sales leadership and his civic activities. While at JC Penney's Mr. Healey was the recipient of the prestigious "James Cash Penney Humanitarian Award for Community Service." Mr. Healey is a former Member of the Board of Governors at Mercy Medical Center and a Past President of the Friends of Mercy. Within the Friends of Mercy, he has served in every capacity on the Board of Sponsors. He has chaired all major fund-raising activities of the Friends of Mercy: The Gentlemen's St. Patrick's Dinner, the Mercy Luau, the Mercy Golf Outing, and the Mercy Ball. In 1972, he was a Member of the Bishop's Honor Guard representing St. Agnes Cathedral High School. He presently serves the Friends of Mercy as the Special Advisor to the Board of Sponsors, the philanthropic group for Mercy Medical Center. In December 2015, Mr. Healey received the distinguished Theodore Roosevelt Award, given by the Nassau Suffolk Hospital Council.

Mr. Healey has also worked for the Town of Hempstead for over 45 years, primarily as an Ocean Lifeguard, Pool Operator, Aquatic Specialist, and presently as a Recreation Supervisor. In June 2002, Mr. Healey received the Town of Hempstead's "Distinguished Service Award" for his service at Ground Zero on September 11, 2001. He has been a Charter Member of the United States Lifesaving Association (USLA). Currently he serves on the Board of Directors, is a National USLA Certification Officer and a National Competition Official. He has served the USLA in both national and international capacities. In April 2004, he was the recipient of the USLA's National "Meritorious Act Award" for a multi-victim drowning prevention. Mr. Healey recently finished up a successful year long celebration as Chairman of the USLA 50th Anniversary Celebration. The USLA has recognized Mr. Healey in 2017, with a "Certificate of Appreciation", in August 2018, with a "National Award for Distinguished Service" and in November 2018, with the unique and rare USLA Life Membership Award. Mr. Healey has served on the St. Agnes Parish Celebration Committee, is a Third-Degree member of the Knights of Columbus, and a member of the Tennessee Squire Association. In September of 2001, Mr. Healey was inducted as a Knight of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem at St. Patrick's Cathedral in New York City. He is still an active member of Floodlight Co. # 1 Emergency & Rescue for the Rockville Centre Fire Department, where he has served as a firefighter and EMT. In June of 2000, the RVCFD awarded Mr. Healey a Certificate of Merit for Outstanding Service, and in May of 2016, the Town of Hempstead recognized Mr. Healey with their "Make A Difference Award."
